“Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me: your rod and your staff, they comfort me” (Psalms.23:4).

In a Sunday School class a boy asked a question to the teacher:” What does the voice of God sound like?” The teacher was not prepared for this kind of a question. She was taken by surprise. All were waiting to see how their teacher would answer the question. She began slowly, saying, the voice of God sounds like...” and drew the words out as long as she could while she prayed desperately that God would speak and give her an answer. She started once again: “The voice of God sounds like...like your best friend, like someone you trust, someone you can really talk things over with. The voice of God sounds like your mother or your father or your favorite sister when they comfort you because you’re having a bad dream in the night. You hear them next to your bed, calling, “Everything is all right, I am right here beside you.” Jesus said “...And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age” (Matthew.28:20b). Really Jesus is the voice of God, In that voice we can hear the consolation of a friend, the words of strength and courage from a superior, words of peace and forgiveness from God. We can hear His voice and feel His presence in our day today life. Our personal and family prayer, meditation on the Word of God and corporate worship will help us to discern His voice.

The 50 days Great Lent begins from February 15.Lent is a special time of self-examination and penitence, a time for self-discipline, prayers, meditation, Bible Study and fasting. Lent speaks clearly God’s inestimable love to human beings and narrates that Christian life is not devoid of sufferings. Jesus never promised a life which is free from sufferings, but instills faith that is strong enough to face suffering. Jesus enjoyed his life on the cross and challenges us by inviting us to take up cross. In the midst of hopelessness and despair, there is a hope for a better tomorrow, because death lost its power and Jesus is the Victor. In this victory, we can claim victory over all forces of evil and death. Let us observe the Great Lent for reconciliation, self- purification of body and minds, manifestation of faithful prayerful cry for the providence of God’s Grace.

The 120th Maramon Convention begins on 08th and end on 15th February. This is one of the biggest Christian gatherings in Asian continent and an annual get together of the Mar Thoma Christians too. Even if we are away from there, we have a spiritual responsibility to pray for the listeners, speakers, and organizers of the convention so that God can transform the life of believers for a better harvest.

Another financial year has rolled past. God has graciously selected us to witness the new financial year so as to challenge us to double our efforts with hard work, dedication and new initiatives. Let us praise God for having showered His manifold blessings up on us in the past year. Hope that the New Year will be a year of God’s further providence in our lives.

Youth Chaplain' Corner

One Lord and one sheep: Unity or division “.....and there shall be one flock and one shepherd.” (John. 10:16)

One of the great visions that Jesus wanted to explain to His disciples is one Lord and one sheep. The oneness of Christians amidst of the diversities is the Lordship of Jesus. But many a time it became a force of division among Christians in the history. Even this was evident in the first century church where Paul asked the question ‘is Christ divided’? When he was writing to the Ephesians Paul clearly explained what is the unity of Christians , “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all”. (Eph. 4. 4, 5) But most of the oneness that Paul is trying to emphasize in these verses became forces of division in the church.

Jesus is telling us today that every Christian is part of His flock and He is the only Lord. Chapter 10 describes this unique relationship a shepherd has with sheep for the unity. The shepherd owns, knows and gives life to these flocks. This is an intimate and unique relationship that a shepherd is having with his sheep. All the sheep have the privilege to believe that there is someone who owns them, knows them and gives life in abundance and that is their shepherd. This intimate relationship should be the catalyst for our unity in Christ. We are one in Christ. John Chapter 10 also talks about the unique characteristics of the sheep that is part of this unity. They listen to the shepherd and will not listen to any other false shepherds because they recognize the voice of the shepherd. They know the shepherd and enter through the gate of Jesus for the salvation. They have no confusions on what they believe and who are the right prophets. Jesus clearly warns about the false teachers and heresies that can come on our way when we live in this world. If we don't listen and know our shepherd then we will easily fall into the trap of division and hatred. Jesus said we will discern the false prophets by their fruits. So teachings and the fruits are to go hand in hand. The question is do we listen to our shepherd and shepherd alone? Do we know Him personally?

All the diversities that we have among Christianity should not be the forces of division and hatred among us but should a unifying force because we have only one Lord. But today it is sad to understand that a lot hatred and division is in the Christian community on what we believe and what we practice. The best answer to find a solution to these divisions is to listen to our shepherd and not be cheated by the false teachings. Let us know him personally then the diversities that we have is a blessing in our growing together. Let us enter through the gate of our Lord and He said ‘I am the gate’.

From Diocesan Episcopa:

Our diocese started the New Year with the Leadership Conference which was attended by about 100 delegates representing various parishes from North America. The youth Fellowship members of the Carmel Mar Thoma Church, Boston, organized the conference very well with the help of the Youth Chaplains in the Diocese and the Diocesan Council Members. The conference was a blessing to all who attended.

The theme was rooted in Christ, based on Col 2: 6-7, which says, “So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.” St. Paul is talking about “Life in Christ” and the need to grow with deep roots. A plant with deep roots will stand strong and will have leaves and fruit in its branches. It reminds us of Psalms 1: 3 “He (the blessed man) is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither.” (Reflect on St. Jn. 15 as well). St. Paul is telling his audience to grow in the Christian doctrines and to find the meaning and relevance of a Christian life. The conference in Boston was the 18th Leadership Conference and was meant for training youth members who are above the age of 21 years to become spiritual leaders in the diocese. Hence the delegates are selected from each parish by the respective Vicars. The Conference has a curriculum that extends over 3 years. Spiritual leaders are identified from among those who (1) are regular communicant members of the Diocese, (2) have completed both courses of the LEAD program, (3) have attended 3 leadership Conferences, (4) have expressed commitment to the ministry in the Mar Thoma Church through a written statement and (5) are above the age of 24 years. St. Paul said to Timothy, in 1 Tim.3:1 that to aspire to leadership is an honorable ambition. In the first century, while St. Paul was ministering, every Christian leader was going through hardship, contempt, rejection and even death. Hence, Christian Leadership is not a position of prestige and respect but the quality of one giving his/her self in service to others, bringing glory to God.

God makes leaders. The personal relationship with God makes a leader humble. When God calls, we cannot refuse due to a sense of inadequacy. The spiritual leader will approach the ministry of leadership willingly and with commitment. Jesus is our model (Mk 10: 38-43). His commandment is to “love as Jesus has loved us.” I wish you all a very blessed and fruitful New Year!
