Vicar's message:

Greetings to you all in the matchless name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It gives me immense pleasure to address you all through this month's Newsletter. The 35th Parish Day of our Church was celebrated in a meaningful way. Once again I would like to congratulate all office bearers and the Church committee members for your timely effort and leadership. Most of the families participated in the One Day Income collection.
