Vicar's message:

Greetings to you all in the matchless name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It gives me immense pleasure to address you all through this month News Letter and I would like to draw your attention to the action plan for the month of October 2016. We have entered the last quarter of this financial year and let us thank God for His innumerable blessing, which are beyond our description and measure. We, as a chosen people of God are always in need of His undying love and infinite wisdom to carry out our duties and responsibilities in a responsible way.

The theme for the Sevika Sangam day was 'Remembering and Celebrating Women's Ministry, observed on second Sunday of September 2016. In St. MK 14: 3 –9, we see the sinful woman who poured such expensive perfume over Jesus. She was rebuked by the men around (v5). But Jesus predicted her reward for the significance she gave him. "I tell you the truth, wherever the gospel is preached throughout the world, what she had done will also be told in memory of her" (v9). This event reminds the following thoughts. 1. The sinful woman submitted the most precious things to God. 2. She broke the Jar and poured the complete perfume on Jesus head. 3. She did what she could. The Bible specified the prominent role of women in God's ministry. Every Christian, male or female, is called to minister in different capacities (Eph. 4: 11 & 12).

As per the Sabha Calendar the first Sunday of October is being observed as 'Voluntary Evangelist's Day' with the theme 'Priesthood of all Believers' (20th Sunday after Pentecost). The second Sunday is being observed as 'Care for the people with Special Skills" (21st Sunday after Pentecost). The theme for third Sunday is 'Youth with Christ' (Youth Sunday) and the fourth Sunday "Family: Space for faith formation" (Christian Family Dedication Day, 23rd Sunday after Pentecost). The fifth Sunday is being observed as *Kudosh Eetho - Sanctification* of the Church (Beginning of the Liturgical Year). We have to make time to mediate and reflect on these themes so that we imbibe its essence and transform ourselves into a community that can extend help, hope and healing to our fellow beings. I

hope and pray that these divinely inspired ideas for life will provide you all the spiritual nourishment and sustenance in the days to come.

A joyful and busy summer has officially ended and autumn has begun, and the nature is preparing to receive one more winter. We can experience nature's beauty more clearly during the fall season. The leaves turning color is just one example of the wonderful beauty that God created on earth. For us this is a marvelous time to focus on God's wonderful blessing – family, friends, shelter, provision, guidance, care, opportunity to serve and ample time to pray (October News Letter, 2015, p.4).

Let us resolve to use our time and talents for His glory, in His Service. Kindly uphold the activities of our parish and its organizations on your prayers. May the Almighty Lord be with us and bless our ways and ministry in this faith journey.

YOUTH CHAPLAIN'S CORNER.

The second Sunday in the month of October is when the Mar Thoma Church will commemorate our solidarity with people who have special skills. We are not born the same, but we are all children of God. We all have different abilities given to us by God. In the Bible there are many people who are differently able. Most of these stories are of people who were healed and made whole. Jesus when he is in Nazareth picks the bible passage from Isaiah, where it was written, "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Throughout his life, Jesus worked hard not just to physically heal people but to also get them accepted by society.

His disciples continued the mission that their master taught them. Acts 3:1-10 is a famous story of Peter and John healing a lame beggar. This passage illustrates some important points in how we should interact with those with special skills:

- 1) Peter and John took the time to talk to the person. They knew that part of their mission was to be with those who are in need.
- 2) Peter took him by the right hand (Acts 3:7). The right hand is often used to symbolize love, blessings, welcome, support, encouragement, and integration (ex. to be seated at his right hand or your right hand sustains me.)

People who are differently abled are also children of God. To make them feel the love of God is part of the reason that Jesus came here on earth. This is also part of the mission that he has entrusted to his disciples.

May we all be faithful in continuing this mission.
