Vicar's message:

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Warm greetings to you all Parish Members in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Lord, our God provides perfect freedom, let's use our blessings meaningfully. As we are entering into the fourth month of the New Year may the Almighty Lord continue to bless you all. I would like to share few thoughts from St. Mathew 15: 21 -28, V 27 "Dogs eat the crumbs that fall off their master's table."

The drive for life is much powerful than death. The Canaanite woman pleaded Jesus to grant healing for her daughter, who is at the verge of death. At first, the woman was unheard by Jesus. Then she was neglected. Finally, she was restored and appreciated. The text is silent about the reason behind Jesus's attitude towards the woman. But the text concludes with a wonderful affirmation of healing for the woman's daughter. Her courage to claim 'the last and least thing' like 'the bread crumbs for dogs,' made the difference. The last thing is the least thing, which is in fact the most important of all. The mustard seed, the widow's mite.... such little things can make a qualitative difference. In order to reclaim such possibilities in the last and least things, we need greater faith (Every Day with the Word, March – June 2017, P.21). So Jesus healed the Canaanite woman's daughter showed the impartiality of the Kingdom of God.

We have entered into another season of the Great Lent focusing now on simple living, prayer and fasting in order to grow closer to God. Lent is not a ritual but an experience of sharing with Christ's suffering. It brings us closer to God. The 50 days of great lent represent the time of preparation for the Church before the

resurrection of Jesus Christ (Easter). The purpose of Lent is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus Christ – His life, suffering, sacrifice, death, burial and resurrection. The Lenten season is also a time of self examination and reflection, or to give up something. It is a time to return to God and re-focus our lives on Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

As we move on, I seek your wholehearted co-operation and support towards our parish and its activities. May the crucified and the resurrected Lord be with us in our daily life, in our ministry and in all walks of life...

Matthew 28:8

As we prepare to celebrate Easter, let us all remember that we are all Children of God. That our Heavenly Father loves all of us, and wants us to love each other. That we are all special in His eyes. That we are all talented and gifted. And that we are all called to spread the Great News of Easter - 'He is not here; for he has been raised!'

From Diocesan Episcopa:

Dearly beloved in Christ,

This is the time of observing Lent when the faithful members of the church devote time for prayer and fasting. It is a time to recollect the great act of God in transforming the world through His redemptive love. Prior to this observance, we had the Maramon Convention, which provided an occasion for the members of the church for renewal and transformation on the basis of the study of the Word of God. It all the more emphasizes that the words spoken by Jesus Christ have relevance to the contemporary life of the faith community, and this understanding will help in the proper manifestation of the Word in the local context.

The Lent meditations focus on the invitation of all to the Kingdom of God and the fullness of life offered by Christ to all sections of society. The wholeness of life through healing is the possibility that all can experience. It also reminds of the sufferings Jesus Christ had to undergo in fulfilling the will of God in the redemptive act. The faithful members of the church observe these days remembering the events on the way of the cross. It is a time to realize how one needs to endure suffering in order to keep the life blossoming. Cross is an experience that leads to ultimate victory, giving new life to carry on the mission of God.

Often, we will have the mind of Peter, rather than the mind of Christ. When Jesus began to ‘teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again’, Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him. But in return, Jesus rebuked Peter, saying, “Get behind me, Satan! For you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men”. (Mk.8:31-33).

Peter represents the world that invites us to climb the ladders; whereas Jesus and the gospel invite us to lift crosses. The choice one has to make is between the ladder and the cross. Yes, success matters, affluence matters, education matters and respect matters. Is it all that

one need to achieve? When the artists want to portray Christ's 'Descent from the Cross', a ladder is propped up against the cross. The ladder symbol shows the removal of Christ from the cross and from our discipleship.

The Gospel according to St. Paul shows "a more excellent way", - a way not of health, wealth and happiness, but of servant hood. Leonard Sweet explains this by narrating the life experience of Mary, the mother of Jesus. "Mary knew that the crucifixion was not a fiction – it was the structuring symbol of her life... Mary was the first to realize that to accept the gospel is to enter a radically plausibility structure. The grace of God takes me "just as I am", but the grace of God does not leave us just as we are. It turns our world upside down. The gospel is not the answer. The gospel is the power to become with one another the body of Christ, where the symbol of success is not a golden throne, but a wooden, rugged cross". (p.153, Soul Café).
